#### Must-See Rome: Small Group Walking Tour

This unique walking tour reveals the city's most beautiful monuments and the secrets of the Roman Dolce Vita.

Departing from the Spanish Steps, you will walk along the exclusive Via Condotti past the boutiques of Armani, Gucci, Bulgari and many other world famous fashion designers.

The Trevi Fountain is next. The most enduring - and maybe the quirkiest - legend about Rome is that throwing a coin into the Trevi Fountain will ensure your return to the Eternal City (an estimated \$4,000 are tossed into the fountain's waters each day). It has become an icon of La Dolce Vita due to its 'starring role' in Federico Fellini's film of the same name.

A little further along you will find the spacious Piazza Colonna, home to Palazzo Chigi, the seat of the Italian government and nearby Montecitorio, which houses the Parliament.

Next up is the Pantheon square, where the Pantheon - one of the greatest and best preserved Roman temples in existence is located. Piazza Navona comes next; here the Baroque age explodes with Gian Lorenzo Bernini's spectacular Four Rivers Fountain.

The Amalfi Drive, connecting Sorrento and Amalfi, is a narrow road that threads along the high cliffs above the Tyrrhenian Sea. #### About the hotel

#### Savor Sorrento: Exploring Tastes and Culture

Tour at 10:30 AM Food, Wine & Nightlife



Thirteen tastings in eight locations in three hours: this walking tour gives you a chance to try all the Southern Italian classics, from street food to dessert, while admiring the views and architecture, and hearing about the town's local history and traditions. We recommend booking the tour early in your stay, so you can get to know Sorrento and will have an overview of all the best eateries for the rest of your time there.

You will meet your guide and group of up to 12 people in Piazza Tasso, Sorrento's main square, and head to a local pasticceria (pastry shop) for a traditional sfoglietella, a flaky pastry filled with flavored ricotta. Next you will sample some rice balls, also known as arancini, a deep-fried Southern Italian street food staple. You will go on to sample excellent panini made with all the freshest ingredients, and visit a family-owned deli where you will taste real buffalo mozzarella, local cheeses, and salumi (cold cuts).

As proof that Italy isn't just a wine-producing country, you will get to taste the area's first artisanal microbrew, which has won awards for its exceptional flavor. You will also be offered a glass of local wine, alongside another long-standing area classic: *Gnocchi alla Sorrentina*, homemade potato dumplings with authentic buffalo mozzarella and tomato sauce, presented at a typical *trattoria*. After a walk in the shade of lemon trees, you will be shown how *limoncello* is made, and be offered a shot to try. The day will end with gourmet *gelato*, famous in Sorrento and far beyond.



#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

This small group gastronomic tour includes 13 food and beverage tastings at eight locations, and an English-speaking guide who will highlight some of the city's best places to eat. Children of all ages are allowed on this tour. Participants on this tour are both Select Italy and non-Select Italy clients. Maximum number of participants is 12. There is no minimum. Please inform us of any dietary restrictions beforehand. Vegetarian and gluten-free options are available. While the area is mostly flat, please make sure to wear comfortable shoes for walking. You will cover about 1.25 miles (2 km) at a comfortable pace with frequent stops and a sit-down lunch. Strollers and wheelchairs can be used on the tour. If rain is forecast, we recommend that you bring an umbrella as you will be outside for most of the tour. Please bring a bottle of water, or be prepared to buy one on the tour. Please note that transportation to/from the tour meeting point in central Sorrento is NOT included in the tour price, but it can be organized for an additional fee.





#### Capri-Island of Romance

Tour at 8:45 AM

The sun-kissed island of Capri, basking in the midst of the Tyrrhenian Sea, has been enchanting visitors for centuries. This full day boat excursion takes you around this stunning Mediterranean island so you can explore its celebrated rocky coastline, which hides many caves and secret grottos in its depths.

Departing from Positano, as you come into Capri you'll pass the infamous Tiberio's leap - legend has it that this was the place where disobedient servants and unwanted guests were thrown over the cliff! Upon reaching the island's port, your captain provides you with maps of the island, as well as information about the must-see sites; then you have about four hours to independently explore the island.

Once you return to the boat, a panoramic ride around the island begins and you will be able to admire Capri's rugged cliffs, white sand beaches, lemon trees, flowers and magnificent views from the water. An optional stop at the beautiful Blue Grotto, known for the intense blue tones of its interior and the magical silvery light, gives you a chance to enter the mouth of the cave to admire the spectacular colors. Then, you'll head to the Green Grotto, named for the emerald colored waters that fill its interior.

Capri's iconic symbol is the trio of three rugged rock formations known as the Faraglioni. On your way to see them, you can stop for a swim in one of the island's hidden bays. Last stop of the tour is the White Grotto. At the conclusion of the excursion, you'll return to Positano with many happy memories and pictures of the fabled isle of Capri.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Transportation to the Positano pier is NOT included in the total price. Please note that if you are NOT staying in Positano, we strongly recommend that you book a private transfer or that you take a cab to the meeting point. If you wish to book a private transfer, we will gladly assist you.
